HEADLICE

Unfortunately headlice are a common problem in all schools. We share your frustration when you treat your child only to find they immediately have them again. The most effective way of keeping on top of the

problem that I have found is conditioning and combing through the hair with a fine comb everytime you wash your child's hair. In this way headlice are often removed before they have had a chance to lay eggs. Keeping long hair tied back also helps.

Please help us with this problem by checking and treating regularly. A fine toothed comb can be purchased from the infant school office.
