Training for Assessors of Unclear Disclosures—1st Phase

Background

Commissioned by the Churches' Agency for Safeguarding on behalf of the Forum this training has been developed in partnership with, and will be delivered by Helen Edwards and Kerry Cleary of the NSPCC.

Training Objective

To promote the welfare of children by facilitating the appointment of suitable individuals to work with children and young people within Churches, utilising consistent standards* across denominations.

Target Group

Church personnel who receive information direct from CRB/Registered Body about criminal convictions of an individual who has applied to work with children and young people.

* A standards paper has been devel-

oped and approved by NSPCC and the Forum. A copy will be supplied to each delegate in advance.

What next?
