

Go Fish

This game, often just known as Fish, is best for 3-6 players, but it is possible for 2 to play. The dealer deals 3 cards to each player. The remaining cards are placed face down to form a stock.

The player to the dealer's left starts. A turn consists of asking a specific player for a specific sound card. For example, if it is my turn I might say: 'Conner, do you have a 'p'?' The player who asks must already hold that card, so I must hold the 'p' to say this. If the player who was asked (Conner), has a card of the named sound ('p' in this case), he must give the card of this sound to the player who asked for it. That player then gets another turn and may again ask any player for any sound card already held by the asker.

If the person asked does not have the card, they say 'Go Fish!' The asker must then draw the top card of the undealt stock. If the drawn card is the sound card asked for, the asker shows it, says the sound and gets another turn. If the drawn card is not the sound card asked for, the asker keeps it, but the turn then passes to the player who said 'Go Fish!'

As soon as a player collects pairs of the same sound, these must be shown and the sound must be said, and placed face down. The game continues until the stock runs out. The player who has the most pairs is the winner.

This game can be played using Camera word flash cards too!
