style	an aromatic, complex and smooth dry white wine with subtle lemon and pear drops, great acidity and balance - this is pretty stunning stuff coming from just down the road - give it a try!

style	a refreshingly light, bright wine with massive pluggability and a touch of class! - vaquero has none of that overly ripe, oaky, cloying, alcoholic richness that one can get in californian/aussie chardonnay, but, has a lovely unoaked richness with fresh citrus fruits galore

grape	75% grenache, 25% syrah	
style	a real blockbuster of a gigondas - this organically farmed 2007 is ravishingly rich, plush and mouth-filling - the supple grenache and syrah blend is screaming with southern french spice and rich, ripe cherry and raspberry flavours

grape	65% tempranillo, 45% garnacha

style	2002 is a stunning ambroise vintage and his old vine production is another triumph with masses of ultra-ripe fruit, gorgeous, fat, rich weight and texture and purity and a long length - the wine is now softening and becoming richer and more complex, as time goes on – a perfect example of luscious, elegant red burgundy
